

# TRAFFIC SAFETY DIVISION APPLICATION FOR CORRESPONDENCE DRIVER EDUCATION SCHOOL (CSDRED)

### For Parents of Prospective Students

The New Mexico Department of Transportation, Traffic Safety Division (TSD) retains authority over all New Mexico driver education schools. As such, preference is given to traditional, face-to-face driver education instruction such as offered by public high school and private driver education school programs.

However, correspondence driver education schools may offer a solution for students in New Mexico who have specific reasons for being unable to attend a traditional, face-to-face driver education school program.

The New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC 18.20.3) establishes the eligibility criteria for students seeking enrollment in a correspondence driver education school program. An application to enroll in a correspondence driver education school will be examined to determine eligibility.
