

Obtaining or Renewing an Ignition Interlock License

1. Make an appointment to have your ignition interlock installed
2. Have a copy of your ignition interlock contract as proof of installation (a sales receipt will not be accepted)
 - a. Must be in effect and current on the date that the license is to be issued or renewed
 - b. Must be complete, including both the vehicle identification number (VIN) and the signature of the interlock provider
3. Signed and notarized 'Affidavit for Ignition Interlock License'
4. Go to any New Mexico Motor Vehicle Department field office
5. Bring identification and proof of insurance
 - a. Must be an original insurance company document (not a photocopy) that clearly identifies you as an insured driver of the vehicle covered by the ignition interlock contract
6. Pay all fees for ignition interlock license

Reinstating Your Driver's License

Before your license can be reinstated, you must meet the following requirements:

- the license revocation period must be completed (both court ordered and MVD requirements)
- all court ordered ignition interlock requirements must be satisfied
- the driver must have completed a minimum of 6 months of driving with an interlock device and license with no attempts to circumvent or tamper with the device
